COUNTRY SILK SCARF

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 18 cm
Length (approx): 150 cm

MATERIALS

Cleckheaton Country Silk 8ply (50g balls)

Main Colour (MC - colour 16) 1
1st Colour (C1 - colour 12) 1
2nd Colour (C2 - colour 13) 1
3rd Colour (C3 - colour 17) 1
4th Colour (C4 - colour 14) 1
5th Colour (C5 - colour 15) 1

One pair of 5.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION

This scarf has been designed at a tension of 28 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over 2x2 rib, using 5.00mm needles and MC.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt = alternate; **approx** = approximately; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease, decreasing; **fol** = follows, following; **incl** = inclusive, including; **K** = knit; **P** = purl; **patt** = pattern; **rem** = remain/ing; **rep** = repeat; **st/s** = stitch/es.



Easy knitting
Extra patience required

SCARF

Using 5.00mm needles and MC, cast on 52 sts.

**** 1st Row** (right side): K3, * P2, K2, rep from * to last st, K1.

NOTE: When pattern specifies 'turn' – proceed as follows to avoid holes in work. Take yarn under needle and onto other side of work, slip next st onto right hand needle, take yarn under needle and back to original position, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed in pattern.

2nd Row: P3, * K2, P2, rep from * to last 5 sts, K2, **turn**.

3rd and Foll Alt Rows: Rib to end.

4th Row: Rib to last 5 sts, **turn**.

6th Row: Rib to last 7 sts, **turn**.

8th Row: Rib to last 9 sts, **turn**.

10th Row: Rib to last 11 sts, **turn**.

12th Row: Rib to last 13 sts, **turn**.

Cont in this manner working 2 less sts as before until the row 'P3, **turn**', has been worked.

Next Row: K3.

Change to C1, **1st Row** (wrong side): P3, * K2, P2, rep from * to last st, P1.

2nd Row: K3, * P2, K2, rep from * to last 5 sts, P2, **turn**.

3rd and foll Alt Rows: Rib to end.

4th Row: Rib to last 5 sts, **turn**.

6th Row: Rib to last 7 sts, **turn**.

8th Row: Rib to last 9 sts, **turn**.

10th Row: Rib to last 11 sts, **turn**.

12th Row: Rib to last 13 sts, **turn**.

Cont in this manner working 2 less sts as before until the row 'K3, **turn**', has been worked.

Next Row: P3. ******

Rep from ****** to ****** using C2, then C3.

Rep from ****** to ****** using C4, then C5.

Cont working in patt in 6 colours as set until work measures approx 150cm from beginning, ending with a completed section of C1, C3, or C5. Cast off loosely in rib.

Sew in all ends.
