



Crochet Hat with earflaps

MATERIALS

Cleckheaton Merino Supreme 100% pure new wool (50g balls)
Quantity: 4

One 5.50mm crochet hook or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; knitter's needle for sewing in ends; cardboard for making pompons.

MEASUREMENTS

To Fit Head: 56cm

TENSION

This Hat has been designed at a tension of 7 patts and 7 rows to 10cm over crossed treble patt, using 5.50mm hook.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg=begin/ning, **ch**=chain, **cm**=centimetres, **cont**=continue, **crab st**=work as for dc but working from left to right instead of right to left so that sts are worked backwards, **dc**=double crochet, **dec**=decrease, decreasing, **fol**=follows, following, **inc**=increase, increasing, a **lp/s**=loop/s, **0**=(zero) - no sts, rows or times, **patt**=pattern, **rem**=remain/ing, **rep**=repeat, **sl**=slip, **sl st**=slip st, **sp/s**=space/s, **st/s**=stitch/es, **tog**=together, **tr**=treble, **yoh**=yarn over hook, **Base (Foundation) chain**=the length of chain made at the beginning of a piece of crochet as a basis for constructing the fabric, **Turning chain**=one, or more chains, depending upon the length of stitch required, worked at the beginning of a row.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

'**Cross**' = miss next st, 1tr in next st, 1tr in missed st.
'**Inc**' = 1tr in next st, 1tr in previous st of last round.
'**Dec**' = (yoh and draw up a lp in next st, yoh and draw through 2 lps) twice, yoh and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

HAT

Please note our crochet terminology is English not American. [link to charts](#)

Using 5.50mm hook, make 4ch and join with a sl st to form a ring.

1st Round: 1ch, 8dc in ring, sl st in first dc.

2nd Round: 1ch, 2dc in same place as sl st, 2dc in each dc to end, sl st in first dc ... 16dc.

3rd Round: 1ch, 2dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in next dc, * 2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc, rep from * to end, sl st in first dc ... 24dc.

4th Round: 1ch, 2dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in each of next 2dc, * 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc, rep from * to end, sl st in first dc ... 32dc.

5th Round: 1ch, 2dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in each of next 7dc, * 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 7dc, rep from * to end, sl st in first dc ... 36dc.

6th Round: 3ch, 1tr in last dc of 5th round, miss first 2dc of 5th round, 1tr in 3rd dc, 1tr in 2nd dc, * '**Cross**', rep from * to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg ... 18 patts.

7th Round: 3ch, 1tr in last tr of 6th round, 1tr in first tr of 6th round, 1tr in top of turning ch of 6th round, * '**Cross**', '**Inc**', rep from * to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg ... 24 patts.

8th Round: 3ch, 1tr in last tr of 7th round, 1tr in first tr of 7th round, 1tr in top of turning ch of 7th round, * ('**Cross**') twice, '**Inc**', rep from * to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg ... 29 patts.

9th Round: 3ch, 1tr in last tr of 8th round, 1tr in first tr of 8th round, 1tr in top of turning ch of 8th round, * ('**Cross**') 3 times, '**Inc**', rep from * to last 6 sts, ('**Cross**') 3 times, sl st in 3rd ch at beg ... 33 patts.

10th Round: 3ch, 1tr in last tr of last round, miss first tr of last round, 1tr in next tr of last round, 1tr in missed tr, * '**Cross**', rep from * to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg ... 33 patts.

Rep 10th round until Hat measures 20cm from beg.

DIVIDE FOR EARFLAPS:

1st Row: 3ch, 1tr in last tr of last round, miss first tr of last round, 1tr in next tr of last round, 1tr in missed tr, ('**Cross**') 11 times, 1tr in next tr, **turn**.

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2nd Row: 2ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, ('Cross') 7 times, **turn**.

3rd Row: 2ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, ('Cross') 6 times, 1tr in next tr, **turn**.

4th Row: 2ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, ('Cross') 5 times, '**Dec**'.

5th Row: 2ch, miss one st, 1tr in next tr, ('Cross') 4 times, '**Dec**'.

6th Row: 2ch, miss one st, 1tr in next st, miss one st, ('Cross') twice, miss one st, '**Dec**'.

Fasten off.

Miss next 24 sts (or 12 patts) across front of hat and join yarn with a sl st in next st.

Next Row: 3ch, ('Cross') 7 times, sl st in 3rd ch at beg of round, sl st in next tr, **turn**.

Next Row: 2ch, 1tr in top of turning ch, ('Cross') 7 times, **turn**.

Rep rows 3 to 6 incl as given for other ear flap.

Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Sew in ends. With right side facing and using 5.50mm hook, work 1 round '**Crab St**' around lower edge of hat and ear flaps.

Fasten off.

Make 2 pompons 3cm in diameter and attach one to end of each ear flap. Using 5.50mm hook, make 2 lengths of ch 6cm long. Attach to each side of hat as buttonhole loops for pompons, so that earflaps can be folded up.



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
