WOMAN

MEASUREMENTS	S	M	L	XL
	8-10	12-14	16-18	20-22
Finished Measurement:	88	98	108	118 cm
Length:	52	53	54	55 cm
Sleeve Length:	43	43	43	43 cm

MATERIALS

Cleckheaton Deluxe Velvet Ribbon (50g balls)
Quantity 11 12 14 15

One pair and one set of double pointed 5.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 4 stitch holders; plain yarn and wool needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 16 sts and 25 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 5.00mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS - **alt**=alternate; **approx**=approximately; **beg**=begin/ning; **cm**=centimetres; **cont**=continue; **dec**=decrease, decreasing; **fol**=follows, following; **inc**=increase, increasing; **K**=Knit; **0**=(zero) - no sts, rows or times, **P**=Purl; **patt**=pattern; **pss**=pass slipped st over, **purl fabric** (reverse of stocking st)=purl right side rows, knit wrong side rows, **rem**=remain/ing; **rep**=repeat; **sl**=slip, **st/s**=stitch/es, **tbl** = through back of loop, **tog**=together.

BACK

Using a pair of 5.00mm needles, cast on **70** (78-86-94) sts.

1st Row (wrong side): Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit, inc 3 sts evenly across ... **73** (81-89-97) sts.

Work rem in stocking st, beg with a knit row, until work measures 30cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Raglan Armholes:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **69** (77-85-93) sts.

Sizes S, M and L only:

1st Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pss, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

4th Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows **4** (2-0) time/s ... **59** (71-83) sts.

Size XL only:

1st Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pss, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

2nd Row: P1, P2tog, purl to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, P1.

3rd Row: As 1st row.

4th Row: Purl.

All Sizes ... 59 (71-83-87) sts.

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pss, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next Row: Purl. **

Rep last 2 rows until **25** (27-29-31) sts rem, ending with a purl row. Leave sts on a stitch holder for neckband.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to **.

Rep last 2 rows until **41** (45-47-51) sts rem, ending with a purl row.

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pss, K12 (13-14-15), turn.

Work on these **14** (15-16-17) sts for left side of neck.

Shape Neck:

*** Dec one st (as in previous rows) at armhole edge in foll alt rows **7** (8-8-9) times, **AT SAME TIME** dec one st at neck edge in foll alt rows **3** (2-4-3) times, then in foll 4th rows **1** (2-1-2) time/s ... 3 sts.

Purl 1 row. ***

Next Row: Sl 1, K2tog, pss ... 2 sts. Fasten off.

Slip next **11** (13-13-15) sts onto a stitch holder and leave for neckband.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem **15** (16-17-18) sts for right side of neck, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog, K1.

Rep from *** to ***.

Next Row: K3tog. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

Using a pair of 5.00mm needles, cast on **32** (34-34-36) sts.

Work 3 rows purl fabric as given for Back, inc 3 sts evenly across last row ... **35** (37-37-39) sts.

Work 6 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row.

Next Row: K2, 'M1', knit to last 2 sts, 'M1' K2 ...

37 (39-39-41) sts.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st at each end of

8th (6th-6th-4th) rows until there are **49** (47-63-55) sts then in foll **10th** (8th-8th-6th) rows until there are

57 (63-67-75) sts.

Cont (without further inc) until work measures 43cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Raglan:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **53** (59-63-71) sts.

Sizes S, M and L only:

1st Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

4th Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows **3** (1-0) time/s ... **45** (55-61) sts.

Size XL only:

1st Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

2nd Row: P1, P2tog, purl to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, P1.

3rd Row: As 1st row.

4th Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows once ... 59 sts.

All Sizes ... 45 (55-61-59) sts.

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until 7 sts rem, ending with a purl row.

Leave sts on a stitch holder for neckband.

NECKBAND

We recommend using 'Mattress Stitch' and plain yarn to sew up your handknit. See knitting Info/knitting techniques on www.cleckheaton.biz.

Join raglan seams, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline. With right side facing, using **double pointed** needles, beg at left raglan seam, work across sts from stitch holders as folls:

1st Round: [K2tog, K5] across sts from left sleeve holder, knit up **12** (13-14-15) sts evenly along left side of front neck shaping, knit sts from front neck stitch holder - dec 3 sts across, knit up **12** (13-14-15) sts evenly along right side of front neck shaping, [K5, K2tog] across sts from right sleeve stitch holder, then [K2tog, K**21** (23-25-27), K2tog] across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **67** (73-77-83) sts.

Purl 3 rounds.

Cast off purlways.

TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams.

GIRL

MEASUREMENTS

Finished Measurement:	63	68	73	78	83	cm
Length:	31	35	39	43	47	cm
Sleeve Length:	23	28	33	38	40	cm

MATERIALS

Cleckheaton Deluxe Velvet Ribbon (50g balls)

Quantity **5 6 7 9 10**

One **pair** and one **set** of **double pointed** 5.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 4 stitch holders; plain yarn and wool needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 16 sts and 25 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 5.00mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS - refer to page 1.

BACK

Using a **pair** of 5.00mm needles, cast on

50 (54-58-62-66) sts.

1st Row (wrong side): Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit, inc 3 sts evenly across ... **53** (57-61-65-69) sts.

Work rem in stocking st, beg with a knit row, until work measures **18** (21-24-26-29) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Raglan Armholes:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **49** (53-57-61-65) sts.

1st Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

4th Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows **1** (2-2-3-4) time/s ... **45** (47-51-53-55) sts.

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next Row: Purl. **

Rep last 2 rows until **23** (25-27-29-31) sts rem, ending with a purl row.

Leave sts on a stitch holder for neckband.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to **.

Rep last 2 rows until **35** (39-43-45-47) sts rem, ending with a purl row.

Shape Neck:

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K**10** (11-13-13-13), **turn**.

Cont on these **12** (13-15-15-15) sts for left side of neck.

Size 2 years only:

Next Row: P2tog, purl to end.

Sizes 4, 6, 8 and 10 years only:

Purl 1 row.

All Sizes ... 11 (13-15-15-15) sts.

*** Working armhole shaping as before, dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until 3 sts rem.

Purl 1 row. ***

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso ... 2 sts.

Purl 1 row.

K2tog. Fasten off.

Slip next **9** (11-11-13-15) sts onto a stitch holder and leave for neckband.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem **13** (14-16-16-16) sts for right side of neck, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1 ...

12 (13-15-15-15) sts.

Size 2 years only:

Next Row: Purl to last 2 sts, P2tog.

Sizes 4, 6, 8 and 10 years only:

Purl 1 row.

All Sizes ... 11 (13-15-15-15) sts.

Rep from *** to ***.

Next Row: K2tog, K1 ... 2 sts.

Purl 1 row.

K2tog. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

Using a **pair** of 5.00mm needles, cast on

25 (27-27-29-31) sts.

Work 3 rows purl fabric as given for Back, inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... **27 (29-29-31-33) sts.**

Work 6 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row.

Next Row: K2, 'M1', knit to last 2 sts, 'M1', K2 ...

29 (31-31-33-35) sts.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st at each end of

6th (8th-10th-12th-10th) rows until there are **37 (39-39-39-37)**

sts, then in foll **8th (10th-12th-14th-12th) rows** until there are

41 (43-43-45-49) sts.

Cont (without further inc) until work measures

23 (28-33-38-40) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Raglan:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **37 (39-39-41-45) sts.**

Size 2 years only:

1st Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

2nd Row: P1, P2tog, purl to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, P1.

3rd Row: As 1st Row.

4th Row: Purl ... 31 sts.

Sizes 6, 8 and 10 years only:

1st Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

4th Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows (**0-1-1**) time/s ... (**37-37-41**) sts.

All Sizes ... 31 (39-37-37-41) sts.

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until 5 sts rem, ending with a purl row.

Leave sts on a stitch holder for neckband.

NECKBAND

We recommend using 'Mattress Stitch' and plain yarn to sew up your handknit. See knitting Info/knitting techniques on www.cleckheaton.biz.

Join raglan seams, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline. With right side facing, using **double-pointed** 5.00mm needles, beg at left raglan seam, work across sts from stitch holders as follows:

1st Round: [K2tog, K3] across sts from left sleeve holder, knit up **9 (11-12-13-14)** sts evenly along left side of front neck shaping, knit across sts from front neck stitch holder dec 4 sts evenly across, knit up **9 (11-12-13-14)** sts evenly along right side of front neck shaping, [K3, K2tog] across sts from right sleeve stitch holder, then [K2tog, **K4 (5-6-7-8)**, K2tog, K7, K2tog, **K4 (5-6-7-8)**, K2tog] across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **50 (58-62-68-74) sts.**

Purl 3 rounds.

Cast off **very loosely** purlways.

TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams.
