

Cleckheaton FREE PATTERN



Dog Coat in Rib pattering

MEASUREMENTS

| To Fit Chest: | 45 | 50 | 55 | cm |
| To Fit Neck (approx): | 35 | 37 | 40 | cm |

MATERIALS

One pair each 4.00mm, 4.50mm, a circular 4.50mm (60cm long) and a set of 4.50mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; a stitch holder; knitter's needle for sewing seams; length of hat elastic.

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 18 sts and 24 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.50mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS - **alt**=alternate; **approx**=approximately; **beg**=begin/ning; **cm**=centimetres; **cont**=continue; **dec**=decrease, decreasing; **fol**=follows, following; **inc**=increase, increasing; **K**=Knit; **P**=Purl; **patt**=pattern; **psso**=pass slipped st over; **rem**=remain/ing; **rep**=repeat; **sl**=slip; **st/s**=stitch/es; **tog**=together. **When instructions read** - 'Cast off 2 sts, K5 (or another number), the st left on the right hand needle after casting off, counts as one st.

NOTE: We recommend knitting Cleckheaton Faux Fur from the outside of every ball throughout the garment. This will maintain a constant direction for the fabric pile.

BODY (Beg at neck)

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 65 (73-79) sts.

1st Row: K2, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

2nd Row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows 12 times (26 rows rib in all).

Change to 4.50mm needles.

Cont in rib, inc one st at each end of every row until there are 93 (101-107) sts.

Shape Leg Openings:

Next Row: Rib 9 (13-16), cast off next 8 sts, rib 59 sts, cast off next 8 sts, rib 9 (13-16) ... 77 (85-91) sts.

NOTE: Leg openings are worked at the same time, wind a small quantity of yarn into a ball for each section.

Next Row (wrong side): With first ball of yarn, rib across next 9 (13-16) sts, with second ball of yarn, rib across 59 sts, with the third ball of yarn, rib to end.

Cont in rib until leg openings measures 5cm, working last row on wrong side.

Next Row: Working from first ball of yarn, rib 9 (13-16), **turn**, cast on 8 sts, **turn**, rib 59, **turn**, cast on 8 sts, **turn**, rib 9 (13-16) ...

93 (101-107) sts. Cont in rib across all sts until work measures 34cm from cast on edge, or until desired length to end of rib cage, working last row on wrong side.

Beg Shaping Side Edges:

Keeping rib correct, cast off 10 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 73 (81-87) sts.

Next Row: Sl 1, K1, psso, rib to last 2 sts, K2tog ... 71 (79-85) sts.

Work 1 row rib.

Rep last 2 rows until 51 (59-65) sts rem.

Cont in rib until work measures 48 (50-52) cm from cast on edge or until desired length to base of tail. Leave sts on a stitch holder.

BACK BAND

Join seam from the neck edge to end of shaping (below leg openings), reversing seam on neck section for 6cm. With right side facing, using a circular 4.50mm needle and beg at seam, knit up 32 (36-38) sts evenly along edge to sts left on stitch holder, rib across sts on stitch holder, dec one st in centre, knit up 32 (36-38) sts evenly along edge to seam ... 114 (130-140) sts.

1st Round: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st round until work measures 2.5cm from beg. Cast off loosely.

LEG BANDS

With right side facing, using a set of 4.50mm needles, knit up 30 sts evenly around leg opening.

Work 2.5cm of rib as given for Back Band.

Cast off loosely in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Thread elastic around neck edge, adjust to fit comfortably around the dog, fasten off.
