


# Cleckheaton FREE PATTERN

 Beginner knitting  
extra patience  
required



## Scarf with contrasting pockets and embroidery

### MEASUREMENTS

Length: 190 cm  
Width: 22 cm

### MATERIALS

Cleckheaton Faux Fur (50g balls)

Main Colour (MC) 4

and Cleckheaton Country 8 ply (50g balls)

Contrast Colour (CC) 2

One pair each of 4.00mm and 4.50mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; knitter's needle for embroidery and sewing seams.

### TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 18 sts and 24 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.50mm needles and MC.

**ABBREVIATIONS** - **beg**=begin/ning; **cm**=centimetres; **incl**=inclusive; **K**=Knit; **P**=Purl; **patt**=pattern; **rep**=repeat; **st/s**=stitch/es; **stocking stitch**=1 row knit, 1 row purl; **tog**=together; **yfwd** = yarn forward – bring yarn under needle, then over into knitting position again, making a st.

**NOTE:** We recommend knitting Cleckheaton Faux Fur from the outside of every ball throughout the garment. This will maintain a constant direction for the fabric pile.

### SCARF

Using 4.50mm needles and MC, cast on 41 sts.  
Work in stocking st until work measures 190cm from beg, ending with a purl row.  
Cast off.

### POCKETS (make 2)

Using 4.00mm needles and CC, cast on 45 sts.

**1st Row:** K1, \* P3, K1, rep from \* to end.

**2nd Row:** P1, \* K3, P1, rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows once.

**Beg eyelet hole patt:**

**1st Row:** Knit. **2nd Row:** Purl.

**3rd Row:** Knit. **4th Row:** Purl.

**5th Row:** K4, \* yfwd, K2tog, K10, rep from \* to last 5 sts, yfwd, K2tog, K3.

**6th Row:** Purl.

**7th Row:** Knit.

**8th Row:** Purl.

**9th Row:** Knit.

**10th Row:** Purl.

**11th Row:** \* K10, yfwd, K2tog, rep from \* to last 9 sts, K9.

**12th Row:** Purl.

Rows 1 to 12 incl form eyelet hole patt for Pockets.

Work a further 34 rows patt.

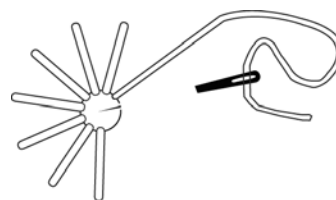
Cast off loosely.

### TO MAKE UP

Using MC and 'Star St', embroider around each eyelet hole. Sew pockets to each end of scarf, placing cast off edge of pocket 1cm from end of scarf, as illustrated.

### Star Stitch

Star Stitch consists of straight sts worked around a central eyelet hole.
